## **Historic Houses Project of Faculty Houses on the Stanford University Campus**

Since 1986, the Governor of the State of California has annually presented the Governor's Historic Preservation Award to organizations, groups, and federal, state and local agencies whose contributions demonstrate outstanding commitment to excellence in historic preservation.

This award recognizes the efforts of the Stanford Historical Society to interpret and gain recognition for historic faculty housing on the Stanford University campus. Through a series of book-length publications, the society has documented and celebrated houses in various quadrants of the campus, which includes the work of Bakewell and Brown, A. B. Brown, Charles Sumner, Birge Clark, and other notable early twentieth century designers.
