

MEMORIAL RESOLUTION

VANDERLYNN STOW (1859 - 1919)

Mr. Vanderlynn Stow, Treasurer and Business Manager of the University, died in San Francisco July 13, 1919. Mr. Stow became a member of the Board of Trustees in 1906. He was made Assistant Treasurer in 1909, Assistant Business Manager in 1912, Treasurer and Business Manager in 1914. In this latter capacity his entire time was devoted to the service of the University, and the nature of his duties brought him into close contact with all the phases and problems of university management.

The Academic Council of the University desires to put on record its appreciation of his devotion to the interests of the University, his courteous consideration of individual difficulties and points of view, and his active sympathy and co-operation in furthering projects for increasing the facilities and widening the influence of Stanford University. His death is a loss to the University, and his personal qualities and services will be gratefully remembered.
